## Nonroad Engine Checklist (Updated 7/5/12)

Complete this form and keep available to help you document that this engine is a nonroad engine. If your engine qualifies as a nonroad engine, it does not need to be included in an air quality permit, but LDEQ recommends that if your engine is a nonroad engine based on Questions C.iii and D below, that you use the attached log to track the location of your nonroad engine.

If your internal combustion engine does not qualify as a nonroad engine, it must be included in an air quality permit, unless it is a motor vehicle per Question A. If circumstances should change so that a nonroad engine will no longer qualify as such, it must be incorporated into an air permit. Failure to do so may result in enforcement action.
