Public Hearing—Substantive Changes to Proposed
Rule AQ240—Emissions Factors
(LAC 33:III.501)(AQ240S)

Under the authority of the Louisiana Environmental Quality Act, R.S. 30:2001 et seq., and in accordance with

the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act, R.S. 49:950 et. seq., the secretary gives notice that the department is seeking to incorporate substantive changes to the proposed amendments to the Air Quality regulations, LAC 33:III.501 (Log #AQ240S), which were originally noticed as AQ240 in the October 20, 2005, issue of the *Louisiana Register*.

The original proposed rule clarifies requirements in LAC 33:III.919 concerning emission inventory and in LAC 33:III.507.H concerning annual compliance certification. The intent of this rule is to permit the department to determine the actual basis of apparent changes in emissions when there is an emission limit discrepancy between a facility's permitted limit (pursuant to Chapter 5) and the emission estimate reported in the facility's emission inventory statement (pursuant to Chapter 9). The department has made substantive changes to further clarify the hierarchy of selecting the available methods to estimate emissions and reflect existing language as specified in LAC 33:III.919 regarding emission data, and to establish a notification mechanism as a means of ascertaining background information to validate reported changes in emissions (that are currently reported under LAC 33:III.919) to assist in the department's ability to conduct case-by-case reviews as provided for in the current proposed rule. No additional fiscal or economic impact will result from the substantive changes.







Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the draft revision to the State Implementation Plan (SIP) for the Lafayette Parish Section 110(a)(1) Maintenance Plan. We have reviewed the draft SIP revision in relation to the May 20, 2005, U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) maintenance plan guidance. We find the SIP revision to be well organized and consistent with this guidance.

We have organized our comments by section in the draft, and when possible, made reference to specific table and paragraph numbers within the submittal.

Attainment Inventory (Section 3)

In Table 3-3, please verify the values of 1.82, 2.32, and 2.19 tpd for the projection of NO_x point source emissions for the years 2008, 2011, and 2014, respectively. If these values are correct, they project a decrease between 2002 and 2008 (2.41 to 1.82 tpd), followed by an increase in 2011 (1.82 to 2.32 tpy), and then another decrease for 2014 (2.32 to 2.19 tpd), which is an unusual pattern. Explanation of this projection's unusual pattern should be discussed more fully in the text.

Ambient Air Quality Monitoring (Section 5)

For Section 5.1, please incorporate the following ozone monitoring information into the text:

Ozone monitoring has been ongoing in Lafayette Parish since 1983 at the following sites:

- a. 1983-1992 at site 22-055-0003
- b. 1992-1993 at site 22-055-0004
- c. 1994-2005 at site 22-055-0005
- d. 2005 and following at site 22-055-0007.

The source of this information is the EPA Quality System (AQS).

In Section 5.2, there is one correction to be made in Table 5-1. Partway down the table, the 2002 8-hour ozone design value should be 0.081 instead of 0.083. Also, the units for this column should be ppm.
