

**Chapter 12: Comprehensive Periodic Implementation Plan
Revisions and Adequacy Determination**

Title 40 CFR §51.308(f) requires states to revise its regional haze implementation plan and submit a plan revision every ten years until 2064. In addition, 40 CFR §51.308(g) requires periodic reports in the form of a SIP revision that evaluates progress towards the reasonable progress goals established for each Class I area. In accordance with the requirement, the LDEQ plans to submit a report to the EPA on reasonable progress every five (5) years following the initial submittal of the Regional Haze SIP. The report will be in the form of a SIP revision and will evaluate the progress made towards the reasonable progress goal for each Class I area located within Louisiana and in each Class I area outside of Louisiana that may be affected by emissions from within Louisiana. All requirements listed in 40 CFR §51.308(g) will be addressed in the SIP revision for demonstrating reasonable progress.

Depending on the findings of the five-year progress report, the LDEQ will examine the actions listed in 40 CFR §51.308(h). The findings of the five-year progress report may determine which action the state may choose as appropriate.
