

LDEQ ANSWERS TO PROPOSER QUESTIONS
RFP No. 2014-03-3901
“Underground Storage Tank Compliance Evaluation Inspections”

LDEQ’s answers to the following questions are intended to provide information to potential proposer questions to RFP No. 2014-03-3901.

Questions and answers that may potentially result in the disclosure of information from proposals of competing bidders will not be published.

Question 1: Is the work for the UST CEIs in a concentrated area or all of LA? A breakdown of number of sites per parish may help to determine what resources from the Veteran Initiative and Hudson Initiative to use relative to the site locations.

Of course, if the site breakdown is not available at this time, (our company) will still be able to perform and use these businesses.

LDEQ’s answer: As stated in Attachment 1 – Statement of Work, Section 1.0, Goals and Objectives, “*The Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality, hereinafter referred to as “the Department”, requires the services of a well-qualified contractor to conduct Underground Storage Tank (UST) Compliance Evaluation Inspections (CEI) at UST facilities throughout Louisiana.*” Based on inspection dates, the Department is currently drafting a list of facilities that will require Compliance Evaluation Inspections during State Fiscal Year 2013-14. The list of facilities that will be assigned to the Contractor has not been finalized at this time but will be available when the contract is awarded.
