WHO MUST SUBMIT THIS APPLICATION:

You must submit this application if you are a sole owner, partnership, corporation, or other organization who is required to be licensed under the Louisiana Revised Statutes 30:2195. A separate application must be submitted for **each** bulk facility in operation.

DEFINITIONS

BULK FACILITY: A facility, including pipeline terminals, refinery terminals, motor fuel distribution terminals, rail and barge terminals, and association tanks, connected or separate, from which motor fuels are withdrawn from bulk and delivered into a cargo tank or a barge used to transport these materials.

CARGO TANK: An assembly that is used for transporting, hauling, or delivering liquids and that consists of a tank having one or more compartments mounted on a wagon, truck, trailer, railcar, or wheels.

MOTOR FUEL: All grades of gasoline, including but not limited to gasohol, No. 1 diesel, No. 2 diesel, kerosene, and all aviation fuels; liquid petroleum (LP) gas shall not be included in this definition of motor fuel.

WITHDRAWAL FROM BULK: The removal of a motor fuel from a bulk facility storage tank directly into a cargo tank or a barge to be transported to another location other than another bulk facility and deposited into an underground storage tank for distribution, direct consumption, or sale in this state.

SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS

- ITEM 1:** Enter the legal name of the corporation, partnership, or other name. If you are a sole owner, enter your first name, middle initial, and last name.
- ITEM 2:** Enter the complete mailing address where you wish to receive mail from the Permits Division.
- ITEM 4:** Enter the Federal Employer's Identification (FEI) Number assigned by the Internal Revenue Service.
- ITEM 7-9:** Complete these sections only if you purchased an existing business that already holds a LDEQ Motor Fuel Delivery Certificate.
- ITEM 11:** Enter the physical location of your business, street address or meaningful directions. Example: "3 miles south of LA 963 on Jones Road." **DO NOT USE** P.O. Box or Rural Route number.
