The Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ) is accepting nominations from prospective solid waste management companies to fill the private service industry vacancy on the Louisiana Board of Certification and Training for Solid Waste Management Operators.

The Board has been instrumental in developing a certification program for the protection of public health and the environment. This certification program covers those solid waste facilities which manage residential and commercial wastes. These facilities include landfills, landfarms, surface impoundments, incinerators, transfer stations, composting, and separation operations.

The term of this appointment is three years, with a potential for re-appointment for another term. The Board meets at least four to five times a year at various locations throughout the State.
