<p>The WrPD's revisions to its whole effluent toxicity (WET) permitting procedures have been implemented. During permit development, the previous five years of WET data will be evaluated using a predictive statistical procedure similar to that presented on pages 52-54 of EPA's <i>Technical Support Document for Water Quality-based Toxics Control</i> (EPA/505/2-90-001, Second Printing) and other available information. If reasonable potential for WET is determined to exist based on the analysis or other available information, WET limits will be included in the permit.
