Chapter 59. Chemical Accident Prevention and Minimization of Consequences

Subchapter A. General Provisions

§5903. Definitions Repealed

~~—The terms in this Chapter are used as defined in LAC 33:III.111 except those terms specifically defined in an applicable subchapter or defined herein as follows:~~

~~—*Full-time Employee*—2,000 hours per year of full-time equivalent employment. A source would calculate the number of full-time employees by totaling the hours worked during the calendar year by all employees, including contract employees, and dividing that total by 2,000 hours.~~

~~—*Major Stationary Source*—a stationary source classified as an A-1 or A-2 source in the Compliance Data System (CDS) maintained by the department.~~

~~—*Owner or Operator*—any person who owns, leases, operates, controls, or supervises a stationary source.~~

§5910. Registration Schedule Repealed

~~—A. Major stationary sources, as defined in LAC 33:III.5903, shall comply with LAC 33:III.5911.~~

~~—B. All stationary sources, including major stationary sources, that have a covered process shall comply with 40 CFR 68.160 on the date specified in 40 CFR 68.10.~~

Subchapter B. Risk Management Program Requirements

§5911. Registration for Major Stationary Sources

~~A. By January 31, 1995, or within one year of the date on which a major stationary source becomes subject to this Chapter after January 31, 1995, the owner or operator of each major stationary source that has a covered process as defined by 40 CFR 68.3 covered by this Chapter shall register with the administrative authority: Louisiana Department of Environmental~~

Quality, Office of Air Quality and Radiation Protection, Air Quality Division by the latest of the following dates:

1. January 31, 1998; or
2. within 60 days after the date on which a stationary source becomes subject to

this Chapter.

1. ~~the name of the major stationary source, the owner/operator, the and its street address, the mailing address, and the telephone number, and the program level (as defined by 40 CFR part 68) of the facility (highest program of a process at the facility, Program 3 being the highest);~~

2. ~~the names and CAS numbers of all regulated substances that are present at the major stationary source in more than the threshold quantities and the maximum amount present in a process at any one time (in ranges) the name, mailing address, and telephone number of the invoicing contact person;~~

3. ~~for each regulated substance, the four-digit SIC code(s) that apply to the use of the substance at the major stationary source the location of the source by parish, and latitude and longitude; and~~

4. ~~the Dun and Bradstreet number of the major stationary source;~~

~~5. the name, address and telephone number of a knowledgeable contact person or a person or position with the overall responsibility for the development, implementation, and integration of accident prevention program requirements; and~~

~~6. the following certification dated and signed by the owner or operator: "The undersigned certifies that, to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief formed after reasonable inquiry, the information submitted is true, accurate, and complete."~~

C. If at any time after the submission of the registration, information in the registration is no longer accurate, the owner or operator shall submit an amended ~~notice~~registration within 60 days to the ~~administrative authority and the~~Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality, Office of Air Quality and Radiation Protection, Air Quality Division.
