

Exxon Co. USA Store 5-3417

The Exxon Co USA Store 5-3417 located in Shreveport originally operated as a full-service gasoline retail facility until 1992. In February 1993, a tank removal action was completed at the site. One fiberglass UST, three steel USTs, one steel used oil tank, and product dispenser lines were removed from the property. The facility became inactive and remained vacant until 1996 when it was purchased by M & M Trailers.

After removal of the tanks and lines, it was determined that the property required further investigation and corrective action to address the remaining contamination. An investigation identified the location of residual soil and groundwater contamination. A corrective action plan was implemented in July 1996 utilizing a Well Point – Recovery Treatment System (WP-RTS) to treat the gasoline constituents in groundwater. The WP-RTS operated continually until January 2003. DEQ required that an additional site assessment and RECAP evaluation be conducted. RECAP standards were established for the site. A RECAP evaluation report was approved by the DEQ establishing the remediation standards for soil and groundwater in July 2003.

On April 7, 2004, DEQ determined that the site had met the established remediation standards for the non-industrial future land use scenario. Therefore, the future property use was unrestricted, and there were no institutional controls needed for the site. The site was subsequently purchased by Wendy's Restaurants and now operates as a retail food service.
