SETTLEMENT

The following Settlement is hereby agreed to between Templeton Trucking Co., Inc. (“Respondent”) and the Department of Environmental Quality (“DEQ” or “the Department”), under authority granted by the Louisiana Environmental Quality Act, La. R.S. 30:2001, et seq. (“the Act”).

I

Respondent is a corporation that owns and/or operates a trucking company located in Rayville, Richland Parish, Louisiana (“the Facility”).

II

On September 1, 2009, the Department issued to Respondent a Consolidated Compliance Order & Notice of Potential Penalty, Enforcement No. SE-CN-08-0265, which was based upon the following findings of fact:

The Respondent owns and/or operates the facility known to the Department as Templeton Trucking Company located at Cabuck Lane in Rayville, Richland Parish, Louisiana (the Site). The Respondent does not have a permit and/or authority of the Department to dispose of solid waste at the Site.

On or about February 13, 2008, and May 9, 2009, the Department conducted inspections of the Site that revealed the following violations:

- A. The Respondent caused and/or allowed the deposition of regulated solid waste without a permit and/or the authority of the Department, in violation of La. R.S. 30:2155 and LAC 33:VII.315.C. The regulated solid waste disposed at the Site includes, but is not limited to, wooden road mat board and wood waste.
- B. The Respondent caused and/or allowed the transportation of solid waste to a disposal facility not permitted to receive such waste, in violation of LAC 33:VII.505.D. Specifically, the Respondent transported woodwaste to the Site which is not permitted to receive such waste.
- C. The Respondent transported regulated solid waste without notifying the Department by submitting a Solid Waste Transporter Notification Form to the Solid and Hazardous Waste Permits Section, in violation of LAC 33:VII.401.A.

### III

In response to the Consolidated Compliance Order & Notice of Potential Penalty, Respondent made a timely request for a hearing.

### IV

Respondent denies it committed any violations or that it is liable for any fines, forfeitures and/or penalties.

### V

Nonetheless, Respondent, without making any admission of liability under state or federal statute or regulation, agrees to pay, and the Department agrees to accept, a payment in the amount of FOURTEEN THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$14,000.00), of which Two Hundred Sixty-Five and 68/100 Dollars (\$265.68) represents the Department's enforcement costs, in settlement of the claims set forth in this agreement. The total amount of money expended by Respondent on cash payments to the Department as described above, shall be

considered a civil penalty for tax purposes, as required by La. R.S. 30:2050.7(E)(1).

## VI

Respondent further agrees that the Department may consider the inspection report(s), the Consolidated Compliance Order & Notice of Potential Penalty and this Settlement for the purpose of determining compliance history in connection with any future enforcement or permitting action by the Department against Respondent, and in any such action Respondent shall be estopped from objecting to the above-referenced documents being considered as proving the violations alleged herein for the sole purpose of determining Respondent's compliance history.

## VII

This agreement shall be considered a final order of the Secretary for all purposes, including, but not limited to, enforcement under La. R.S. 30:2025(G)(2), and Respondent hereby waives any right to administrative or judicial review of the terms of this agreement, except such review as may be required for interpretation of this agreement in any action by the Department to enforce this agreement.

## VIII

This settlement is being made in the interest of settling the state's claims and avoiding for both parties the expense and effort involved in litigation or an adjudicatory hearing. In agreeing to the compromise and settlement, the Department considered the factors for issuing civil penalties set forth in La. R. S. 30:2025(E) of the Act.

## IX

The Respondent has caused a public notice advertisement to be placed in the official journal of the parish governing authority in Richland Parish, Louisiana. The advertisement, in

form, wording, and size approved by the Department, announced the availability of this settlement for public view and comment and the opportunity for a public hearing. Respondent has submitted an original proof-of-publication affidavit and an original public notice to the Department and, as of the date this Settlement is executed on behalf of the Department, more than forty-five (45) days have elapsed since publication of the notice.

#### X

Payment is to be made within ten (10) days from notice of the Secretary's signature. If payment is not received within that time, this Agreement is voidable at the option of the Department. Payments are to be made by check, payable to the Department of Environmental Quality, and mailed or delivered to the attention of Accountant Administrator, Financial Services Division, Department of Environmental Quality, Post Office Box 4303, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, 70821-4303. Each payment shall be accompanied by a completed Settlement Payment Form (Exhibit A).

#### XI

In consideration of the above, any claims for penalties are hereby compromised and settled in accordance with the terms of this Settlement.

#### XII

Each undersigned representative of the parties certifies that he or she is fully authorized to execute this Settlement Agreement on behalf of his or her respective party, and to legally bind such party to its terms and conditions.
