BATON ROUGE – Enviroschool is a training session presented by the Department of Environmental Quality that helps the public better understand the agency and how it operates. In October, Enviroschool will present a combination of two topics: Permits 101: Understanding the basics and Air Permits 101: Understanding the process.
