**SECOND EXTENSION OF  
AMENDED DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY  
AND ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

**ORDER**

Pursuant to the authority granted to me by Louisiana Revised Statutes 30:2001 *et seq.*, and particularly La. R.S. 30:2033 and 2011(D)(6), I hereby find that the emergency conditions set forth in the "Amended Declaration of Emergency and Administrative Order" regarding Hurricane Gustav and its aftermath, as extended on November 5, 2008, continue to exist, and I hereby again extend said declaration of emergency and administrative order through January 5, 2009.

**After January 5, 2009, any further extensions of the "Amended Declaration of Emergency and Administrative Order" will apply only to those parishes that provide information that justifies, in the sole discretion of the Secretary, a finding that the continuation of the regulatory flexibility afforded by this Declaration and Order is necessary to prevent irreparable damage to the environment and serious threats to life or safety in that parish.**
