
ORDER

§ 1. Extension

R.S. 30:2033 and 2011(D)(6), I hereby find that the emergency conditions set forth in the "Seventh Amended Declaration of Emergency and Administrative Order" regarding Hurricane Katrina and its aftermath, as extended by this agency on October 27, 2006 by the "Extension of Seventh Amended Declaration of Emergency and Administrative Order", continue to exist and hereby further extend said declaration of emergency and administrative order for a period of sixty (60) days.
