
2nd EXTENSION OF FIFTH AMENDED DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY AND ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

ORDER

§ 1. Extension

Pursuant to the authority granted to me by Louisiana Revised Statutes 30:2001 et seq., and particularly La. R.S. 30:2033 and 2011(D)(6), I hereby find that the emergency conditions set forth in the "Fifth Amended Declaration of Emergency and Administrative Order" regarding Hurricane Rita and its aftermath, as extended by this agency on October 27, 2006 by the "Extension of Fifth Amended Declaration of Emergency and Administrative Order", continue to exist and hereby extend said declaration of emergency and administrative order for a period of sixty (60) days.
