### **Permit status query and air requirements libraries now available online**

**BATON ROUGE** – The Department of Environmental Quality has recently made it much easier for the public to check the status of permits and to review current air regulations.

DEQ's Web site now includes a link whereby users may enter a search by AI number, company name, data or application start date to check the status of their permit. The permit status query can be found by logging on to <http://www.deq.louisiana.gov/portal/ONLINESERVICES/CheckPermitStatus.aspx> and entering the appropriate data to conduct a permit status search.

Additionally, various air requirements are now available online in a series of libraries. By going to <http://www.deq.louisiana.gov/portal/tabid/3035/Default.aspx>, users can click on a drop down menu and select the particular area of interest. The menu includes requirements for federal, state, industry or equipment-specific as well as requirements for Standard Oil and Gas Air (SOGA) permits.

“By making these search capabilities available to the public, users can access up-to-date information regarding the status of a permit, along with the associated regulations,” said Cheryl Nolan, DEQ Assistant Secretary.
