DEQ reaches agreement for \$100,000 from St. Tammany entities

BATON ROUGE – The Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality has reached a settlement agreement with nine St. Tammany entities for a wide range of environmental violations. The agreement calls for the facilities to pay the department \$100,000. The settlement addresses more than a dozen violations, going back to 2001.

The agreement includes eight businesses. They are Slidell Landfill, Coastal Waste Services, CJS Environmental, Paris Properties, CJS Real Estate, Marlstone Properties, Kidz Klub House, and Pearl River Transport. One trust fund is also involved and that is the testamentary trust of Johnny F. Smith.

Violations include exceedances in wastewater discharge limits, mismanagement of sewage sludge and a fish kill.
