Four UST owner/operator training sessions scheduled in January

BATON ROUGE – The Underground Storage Tank Division of the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality will conduct free training sessions for UST owners and operators this month. The training is mandatory for all UST owners and operators, and must be completed within 9 months of their last UST inspection date. All UST owners and operators must complete their training by Aug. 8, 2012. Additional sessions will be held in March.

The training will provide an in-depth understanding of day-to-day UST operations, maintenance and record keeping procedures in order to ensure fulfillment of compliance and regulatory requirements which are protective of human health and the environment.
