Upper Terrebonne Basin Water Quality Improvement Project to hold meeting on March 30

BATON ROUGE – The Upper Terrebonne Basin will hold a Water Quality Improvement Project public meeting on March 30 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:45 p.m. at the Iberville Parish Civil Center, 24700 J. Gerald Berret Blvd. in Plaquemine. At the meeting, information will be presented to the public regarding the project, along with methods in which citizens may improve water quality within the streams, rivers and bayous of Iberville, Pointe Coupee and West Baton Rouge parishes.

The goal of the Upper Terrebonne Basin Water Quality Improvement Project is to identify and implement ways in which water resources in the Tri-Parish region of Pointe Coupee, Iberville and West Baton Rouge can be improved. The project will address several watershed issues, such as water quality improvement, erosion and flood control, enhancement of fish and wildlife habitats, sedimentation and various environmental improvement measures.

The project is being funded by the Tri-Parish Partnership with financial support from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality under Clean Water Section 319 Project guidelines.
