DEQ Waste Permits Division permit applications are online

BATON ROUGE – The Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality has posted applications for most of the permits DEQ’s Waste Permit Division issues on line. This is part of the DEQ E-business initiative

Applicants for waste permits can now find applications for Type I/II landfills, Type III C/D and/or Woodwaste landfill, Type I/II Surface Impoundment, Type I/II Processing and Type III Woodwaste processing and/or Separation on the DEQ Web site at www.deq.louisiana.gov/portal/DIVISIONS/WastePermits/SolidWastePermitApplications.aspx.

Currently, the department is working on a project to get permit applications for waste tire processing and composting facilities available online.

“Having the waste permits applications available online is one way that DEQ can expedite the application process,” said Sam Phillips, Assistant Secretary for Environmental Services. “This will save money and time and make the permitting process more efficient.”
