### Enviroschool workshops scheduled for July

BATON ROUGE – Enviroschool workshops, presented by the Department of Environmental Quality, help the public better understand the agency and how it operates. In July, the workshop topic for Baton Rouge, Shreveport, Lake Charles and New Orleans will be Remediation 101. In this session participants will be provided an overview of the role and activities handled by the Remediation Services Division including understanding remediation, Brownfields basics and the Risk Evaluation/Corrective Action Program (RECAP). The workshop topic for Alexandria and Monroe is Surveillance and Enforcement 101: How the process works. This session will focus on the roles and processes of the Surveillance and Enforcement Division including facility inspections, ambient monitoring, enforcement referral and enforcement actions.
