Chapter 5. Permit Procedures

§513. General Permits, Temporary Sources, and Relocation of Portable Facilities

A. General Permits

1. The permitting authority may issue a general permit intended to cover numerous similar sources or activities. General permits shall be issued in accordance with LAC 33:III.519 and, prior to issuance, shall undergo public notice and, if the general permit is intended to cover a *Part 70 source* as defined in LAC 33:III.502, review by affected states and EPA in accordance with LAC 33:III.531 and 533. Each general permit shall incorporate terms and conditions applicable to sources ~~which~~ that would qualify for the general permit. Any general permit shall identify criteria by which sources may qualify for the general permit, and may provide for applications which deviate from the requirements of LAC 33:III.517.

2. The owner or operator of any source ~~which~~ that would qualify for the general permit may apply for authorization to operate under the general permit. The application must include all information necessary to determine qualification for and to assure compliance with the general permit. The owner or operator of a *Part 70 source* as defined in LAC 33:III.502 shall publish a notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the local area where the source is or would be located.

6. General permits shall not be issued for new *major stationary sources* and *major modifications* as defined in LAC 33:III.504 or 509.
