Lead Risk Assessment Information in Accordance with Act 893

Louisiana Act 893 (2026) requires an owner, operator, or governing authority of certain facilities that serve young children to identify and address lead hazards in paint, dust, and soil before beginning operation. The following information is provided to assist the owner, operator, or governing authority in complying with Act 893 requirements before operation of a facility that serves young children.

1. Act 893 applies to a facility constructed prior to 1978 that begins operating on or after August 1, 2026 and meets one of the following criteria:
 - An early learning center subject to Louisiana Department of Education (LDOE) licensing requirements;
 - An early childhood care and education center subject to federal daycare licensing requirements;
 - A public prekindergarten program that is part of a public elementary school; or
 - An approved nonpublic prekindergarten program that is part of an approved nonpublic elementary school.
2. If your facility was constructed in 1978 or later, proof of facility construction date shall be attached to the *Lead Risk Assessment Notification Form (LRN)* (see Section I).
3. If your facility was constructed prior to 1978, a risk assessment may or may not be required. A risk assessment is not required if ALL portions of the facility and its grounds had a lead inspection, a lead risk assessment, or been the subject of lead abatement or lead remediation in 1978 or later. However, if any portion of the facility or its grounds did not have a lead inspection or lead risk assessment, or was not the subject of lead abatement/lead remediation in 1978 or later, that portion of the facility or its grounds is required to have a risk assessment (see Section II).
4. If your facility had a lead inspection, lead risk assessment, or was the subject of lead abatement/lead remediation in 1978 or later, proof of prior lead inspection, lead risk assessment, or lead abatement/lead remediation shall be attached to the *Lead Risk Assessment Notification Form (LRN)* (see Section II).
5. If you are required to have a lead risk assessment, it must be conducted by a Louisiana-accredited lead risk assessor. The Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (LDEQ) provides a list of accredited lead risk assessors at <https://internet.deq.louisiana.gov/portal/divisions/lead/lead-risk-assessors>.
6. If you are required to have a lead risk assessment, the certification statement in Section III must be signed by the lead risk assessor. A copy of the lead risk assessor's certificate of accreditation shall be attached to the *Lead Risk Assessment Notification Form (LRN)*. Be sure the accreditation is current for the date that the lead risk assessment was conducted (see Section III).
7. Submit the **signed original** *Lead Risk Assessment Notification Form (LRN)*, with required attachment(s) (see Nos. 2, 4, and 6, above) to the LDEQ at one of the following addresses:

Documentation obtained from LDEQ showing the lead hazard has been addressed must be uploaded to the LDOE with the LRN form.
