PROCEEDINGS UNDER THE LOUISIANA **ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT**

LA. R.S. 30:2001, ET SEQ.

SETTLEMENT

The following Settlement is hereby agreed to between Texas Eastern Transmission, LP ("Respondent") and the Department of Environmental Quality ("DEQ" or "the Department"), under authority granted by the Louisiana Environmental Quality Act, La. R.S. 30:2001, et seq. ("the Act").

Ι

Respondent is a partnership that owns and/or operates natural gas transmission facilities located in Iberville Parish, West Feliciana Parish, and Beauregard Parish, Louisiana ("the Facilities").

II

On December 20, 2019, the Department issued to Respondent a Notice of Potential Penalty, Enforcement Tracking No. AE-PP-18-00678 (Exhibit 1).

III

Respondent denies it committed any violations or that it is liable for any fines, forfeitures and/or penalties.

Nonetheless, Respondent, without making any admission of liability under state or federal statute or regulation, agrees to pay, and the Department agrees to accept, a payment in the amount of EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$8,500.00), of which Nine Hundred Sixty-Four and 94/100 Dollars (\$964.94) represents the Department's enforcement costs, in settlement of the claims set forth in this agreement. The total amount of money expended by Respondent on cash payments to the Department as described above, shall be considered a civil penalty for tax purposes, as required by La. R.S. 30:2050.7(E)(1).

V

Respondent further agrees that the Department may consider the inspection report(s), permit record(s), the Notice of Potential Penalty and this Settlement for the purpose of determining compliance history in connection with any future enforcement or permitting action by the Department against Respondent, and in any such action Respondent shall be estopped from objecting to the above-referenced documents being considered as proving the violations alleged herein for the sole purpose of determining Respondent's compliance history.

VI

This agreement shall be considered a final order of the Secretary for all purposes, including, but not limited to, enforcement under La. R.S. 30:2025(G)(2), and Respondent hereby waives any right to administrative or judicial review of the terms of this agreement, except such review as may be required for interpretation of this agreement in any action by the Department to enforce this agreement.

VII

This settlement is being made in the interest of settling the state's claims and avoiding for

both parties the expense and effort involved in litigation or an adjudicatory hearing. In agreeing to the compromise and settlement, the Department considered the factors for issuing civil penalties set forth in La. R. S. 30:2025(E) of the Act.

VIII

As required by law, the Department has submitted this Settlement Agreement to the Louisiana Attorney General for approval or rejection. The Attorney General's concurrence is appended to this Settlement Agreement.

IX

The Respondent has caused a public notice advertisement to be placed in the official journal of the parish governing authority in Iberville Parish, West Feliciana Parish, and Beauregard Parish, Louisiana. The advertisement, in form and wording approved by the Department, announced the availability of this settlement for public view and comment and the opportunity for a public hearing. Respondent has submitted an original proof-of-publication affidavit and an original public notice to the Department and, as of the date this Settlement is executed on behalf of the Department, more than forty-five (45) days have elapsed since publication of the notice.

X

Payment is to be made within ten (10) days from notice of the Secretary's signature. If payment is not received within that time, this Agreement is voidable at the option of the Department. Payments are to be made by check, payable to the Department of Environmental Quality, and mailed or delivered to the attention of Accountant Administrator, Financial Services Division, Department of Environmental Quality, Post Office Box 4303, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, 70821-4303. Each payment shall be accompanied by a completed Settlement Payment Form (Exhibit A).

In consideration of the above, any claims for penalties are hereby compromised and settled in accordance with the terms of this Settlement.

XII

Each undersigned representative of the parties certifies that he or she is fully authorized to execute this Settlement Agreement on behalf of his or her respective party, and to legally bind such party to its terms and conditions.


This NOTICE OF POTENTIAL PENALTY is issued by the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality (the Department), under the authority granted by the Louisiana Environmental Quality Act (the Act), La. R.S. 30:2001, et seq., and 30:2050.3(B).

An authorized representative of the Department inspected the abovementioned facility or conducted a file review of the facility to determine the degree of compliance with regulations promulgated in the Louisiana Administrative Code, Title 33. The State regulatory cito

The notification was to be submitted to the Office of Environmental Services on or before May 1, 2017, notifying whether each affected point source will comply with LAC 33:III.2201.K.1 or LAC 33:III.2201.K.3 during period of start-up and shutdown. The Respondent submitted the required notification on May 4, 2017 for EQTOOD The Respondent's failure to timely submit the required notification is a violation of LAC 33:III.2201.K.4 and La. R.S. 30:2057(A)(2).

On or about March 20, 2017 the revisions were made to LAC 33:III.Chapter 22, specifically LAC 33:III.2201 C and K (the Work Practic Standards During Start-up and Shutdown) [AQ364]. Pursuant to LAC 33:III.2201.K.4, the Respondent wa required to notify the Office of Environmental Services whether each affected point will comply with Paragraph K.1 or K.3 of the Section during periods of start-up and shutdown. The notification was submitted on or about May 4, 2017. Failure to comply with the reporting requirement is a violation of LAC 33:III.2201.K.4 and La. R.S. 30:2057(A)(2).

File Review 10/17/2018 10/22/2019 AI #7345	In the 2017 First Semiannual Monitoring Report dated September 28, 2017, the Respondent reported the failure to notify the Department of performance/emission tests for E-1 – E-4 General Electric Gas Turbine: (EQT 0001-0004) at least thirty (30) days prior to the tests. The tests were conducted on May 24, 2017 notification was due on or before April 24, 2017. Each failure to submit notification at least thirty (30) days prior to the performance/emission tests is a violation of Specific Requirements 5, 13, 20, and 27 of Title Nermit No. 3160-00007-V4, LAC 33:III.501.C.4, and La. R.S. 30:2057(A)(2).

Specifically, as reported in the facility's 2017 Title V Annual Compliance Certification dated March 8, 2018, EQT 0007 was constructed on March 2, 2017. This is a violation of 40 CFR 60(a)(1) as incorporated by reference in LAC 33:III.3003, Specific Requirement 6 of Title V Permit No. 0320-00016-V4, LAC 501.C.4, and La. R.S. 30:(2057(A)(2).

If the Respondent chooses not to submit the requested most current annual gross revenues statement within ten (10) days, it will be viewed by the Department as an admission that the Respondent has the ability to pay the statutory maximum penalty as outlined in La. R.S. 30:2025.

- DO NOT submit payment of the offer amount with the form. The Department will review the settlement offer and notify the Respondent as to whether the offer is or is not accepted.
