DEQ Enviroschool to host free LPDES General Permit workshops in June

BATON ROUGE - DEQ's Enviroschool program is hosting free sessions on the Louisiana Pollution Discharge Elimination System general water discharge permits in four locations around the state in June. The session on LPDES permits will provide an understanding of water discharge applicability, outfall schedules and how effluent limits and requirements are derived. It will also include a basic overview of stormwater general permits and requirements and preview several new general permits.

Enviroschool provides training for communities, businesses and other organizations on many regulatory topics. The goal of Enviroschool is for the attendees to become informed about the environmental regulatory process in order to maintain and improve environmental compliance.
