Comments can be submitted by one of the methods listed below. If LDEQ cannot read your comments due to technical difficulties and cannot contact you for clarification, then the LDEQ may not be able to consider your comment.

Online:

Comments may be submitted online on the LDEQ public notice webpage at <https://www.deq.louisiana.gov/public-notice>.

Email:

Comments may be submitted to DEQ.PUBLICNOTICES@LA.GOV. The maximum allowed email size is 15 MB. Electronic files should be in .pdf, avoid use of special characters and encryptions, and be free of any defects or viruses. .vsd and .zip file extensions are quarantined for 7 days by the statewide email system. The following file extensions are blocked by statewide email system:

Drop Box:

Comments may be delivered to the drop-box on the first floor of LDEQ Headquarters at 602 N. 5th St., Baton Rouge, LA 70802. Prior to placement in the drop-box, these comments must be stamped by the LDEQ date/time stamp. Comments not date/time stamped may not be considered.
